Where: Cross Keys Village, Harmony Ridge Community Center, 620 Harmony Drive, Encore Room. Cross Keys Village is about 11 miles east of Gettysburg just off US Rt. 30.

When: Eight sessions from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Classes start on Saturday, January 6, 2018 and continue each Saturday until March 10, 2018. An exam session will be offered on Saturday, March 17. You may also take the exam on another date and location of your choosing.

If you have a Technician Class license and you're ready to get onto the worldwide HF bands, it is time to upgrade to General class! The worldwide propagation conditions are currently the best in years!

This training gives you everything you need to pass the written examination for a General Class Amateur Radio license. When you pass the exam you'll leave with your new privileges immediately!

The General Class exam is similar to the Technician Class exam you already passed – 35 multiple-choice questions taken from a published pool of questions – but the information you need to know is more technically complex. Even if you got your Tech license on your own, you should let us help you prepare for the General exam.

There is no charge for this course, but you must purchase your own copy of the *ARRL General Class License Manual*. More details are available on the class web page; <http://www.w3kgn.org/> and click on the **Classes** link in the menu on the left side.
